## General Excellence Entering Years 6 – 8

These scholarships are awarded to students **not** currently at the School and entering Years 6-8, who display excellence in academic, sporting and/or cultural fields. Students will be required to attend an interview with the Principal. All candidates will be informed of the decision regarding the scholarship.

The value of these scholarships is a proportion of the tuition fee for one to three years (depending on year entry level), and are valued at \$4,000 per annum.

### Conditions and Regulations of Scholarships

- Applications close 4:00pm, Friday, 21 October, 2016. Late applications will not be accepted
- The selection process is subject to the Principal's discretion, and will take up to two weeks
- Applicants will be required to attend an interview
- All applicants will be notified by the beginning of November 2016
- Scholarships are available to NZ residents only
- Only one scholarship will be awarded per family
- Current tuition fees for Year 6 are \$11,475 and, for Year 7 and 8 students, \$12,125 per annum. The 2017 fees will be available from the Front Office (06 353 2302) in the next few weeks
- Incidental costs, which include uniform, camp fees, stationery, technology fee and building levy etc. could be approximately \$2,000. These costs are a parent/caregiver cost and are not covered by the scholarship
- The Carncot Trust Board reserves the right not to award any or all of the scholarships offered, if the candidates do not reach the required standard
