UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

- Students at Carncot Independent School have worn their uniform with pride through the years, a tradition that we continue to support to this day.

- All items of clothing need to be clearly named, immaculately clean and well maintained.

WINTER UNIFORM - BOYS (Terms 2 and 3)

- dark navy shorts
- short-sleeved blue school shirt
- school tie
- dark navy school jersey (must be worn to and from school)
- dark navy socks knee height
- black lace-up shoes (please see accessories page for details)

(optional item: school winter jacket)

On formal occasions, boys wear their Winter Uniform.



WINTER UNIFORM - GIRLS (Terms 2 and 3)

- dark navy dress (worn to mid-calf length)
- short-sleeved or long-sleeved blue school blouse
- school tie
- school cardigan (must be worn to and from school)
- over-the-knee black socks or plain black (not sheer) tights
- black T-bar buckle shoes (please see accessories page for details)
- pinafore for over the dress (Years 1 and 2)

(optional items: scarf and school winter jacket)

On formal occasions, girls wear Winter Uniform with a short-sleeve blouse.



SUMMER UNIFORM - BOYS

(Terms 1 and 4)

- dark navy school shorts
- short-sleeved blue school shirt
- school jersey
- black shoes, option of winter lace-up shoes with black crew socks or roman sandals
- school sun hat



SUMMER UNIFORM - GIRLS

(Terms 1 and 4)

- dark navy school shorts
- short-sleeved blue school blouse
- school cardigan
- black shoes, option of T-bar buckle McKinlays shoes with black crew socks or black Mckinlays sandals or roman sandals
- school sun hat



PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIFORM

- physical education shorts
- physical education shirt
- white ankle socks and sports shoes

Years 1-5

- Carncot Fleece*

Years 6-8

- Carncot Navy Tracksuit

Children are required to bring their Physical Education Uniform to school on a Monday in a sports bag, and they take it home at the end of the week.

SPORTS UNIFORM

For students representing Carncot in sports teams or events, the uniform shop will issue a loan of the items required. An annual loan fee will be charged to the student's incidental account.

- sports shorts
- sports skirt (short black bike pants are required underneath)
- basketball singlet (numbered)
- singlet



ACCESSORIES

Jewellery

Jewellery may not be worn. This includes earrings of any kind. Clear, plastic keepers may be worn in the ears, if piercings need to be kept open. Any jewellery exemption (for example, on cultural or religious grounds) must be sought in writing from the Principal. A watch may be worn, with dark or neutral colours being preferable.

Jackets

An embroidered school winter jacket is available for purchase from the Uniform Shop. We will accept plain dark navy jackets as an alternative.

Umbrella

A Carncot School umbrella is available for purchase from the School Office.

Shoes

Tidy plain black school shoes are important. Below are some examples of correct shoe options for students. These are available for purchase from Kelly's Footwear, 507 Main Street, Palmerston North. Boys are required to wear Ascent. Girls are required to wear McKinlays. Black roman sandals can be worn by both girls and boys.



HOUSE APPAREL

House T-Shirts

The House t-shirts were designed by our Carncot students and students are required to wear them for competitive House events during the year.

House Swimming Caps

House swim caps are compulsory for swim lessons and swimming sports.

House Badges

House badges can be worn on the formal school uniform.

All House apparel is available for purchase through the Uniform Shop.



HELPFUL INFORMATION

- In the interests of uniformity, unless specified, items are available for purchase through the Uniform Shop, which is located upstairs in the administration building.
- The Uniform Shop is open on Wednesday 3pm – 4pm or by appointment.
- A small selection of second-hand uniforms are available for sale through the Uniform Shop.
- Girls' hair must be tied back, if not clear of the collar. Hair ties and clips can be black, navy or hair colour. No extra accessories are to be worn eg scrunchies, butterflies or fancy decorations. Regulation head bands are available for purchase through the Uniform Shop.
